Dear friends of KumboKids and Community,

Happy Easter to you all! May the risen Christ rekindle the gift of faith in you, which you all received at Baptism. Holy Week is the culmination of Christ's passion, death, and resurrection. Easter then celebrates the victory of Christ over death, the Resurrection, which is the "raison d'être" (reason to be) of our faith. The Holy Father, Pope Leo XIV, reminds us that Easter "should be the holiest, most sacred time of the year. It is a time of peace, a time for much reflection."

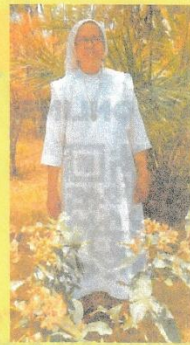
When I read the first part of the Holy Father's message, I experienced some serenity which was quickly overcome by the second part of the message: "but as we all know, once again in the world, in so many places, we are seeing so much suffering, so many deaths, even innocent children." Cameroon has been experiencing this situation since 2016. Many children are unable to attend school, people cannot treat themselves when they get sick because of abject poverty, there are no farm-to-market roads for farmers to sell their products and get an income, and many villages still lack water, electricity, and some lack even basic needs like shelter and clothing. However, ***I write this Easter message to you with hope and a grateful heart because you are helping me to support others.***

(We have some testimonies here:)

My name is Dinayen Marie Claire Fonyuy. I come from a family of 9 siblings, and I am in the 8th position. I am in St. Augustine's College (Catholic Secondary School), Kumbo. My parents live in the village and are involved in traditional farming practices to provide for our daily bread. With the outbreak of this crisis in Cameroon, life became so expensive, especially education, and my parents found it so challenging to meet my educational needs and those of my siblings. I want to thank Father Emmanuel Fale so much for helping me to attain a better education in my dream school environment.

With this opportunity, I will not only succeed in my exams but also become a great person in the future because I believe that education is the key to so many doors. I so much desire to be a doctor or a nurse, depending on the opportunity I can have after I complete high school. In this way, I will also be able to help others with what I can offer and to fight against poverty and suffering. I promise never to disappoint you, Father. Thank you very much. May God bless and reward you and your benefactors.

Through your support, we have been able to provide tuition for many needy kids, to help carry out projects that benefit the community and to continue building the new church in Nkanchi Village. Every year we pay tuition for students in need from Kindergarten through Primary schools, and from Secondary schools to the University.

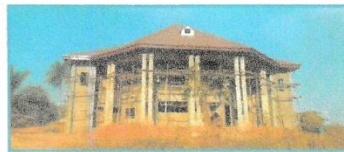

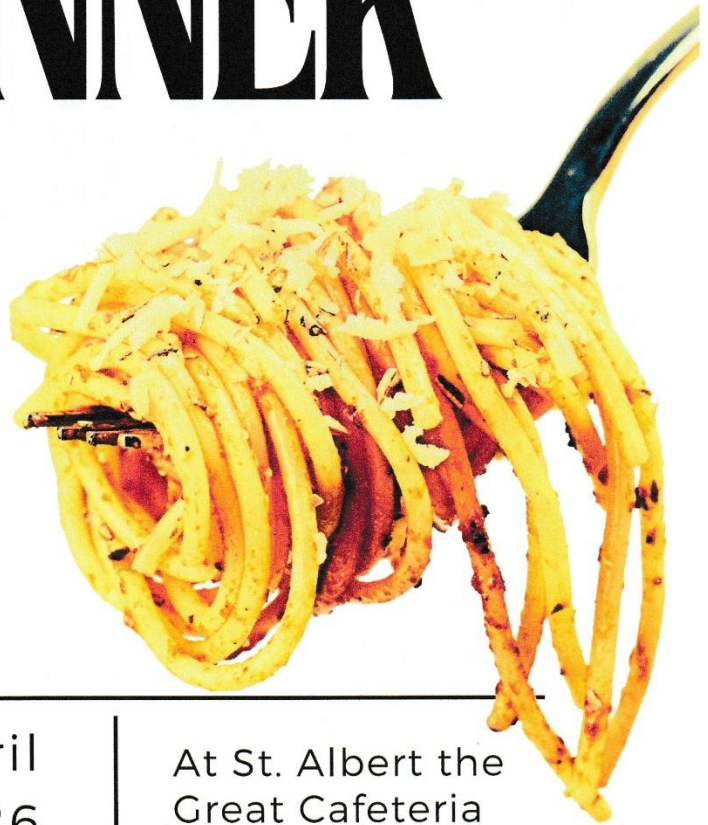

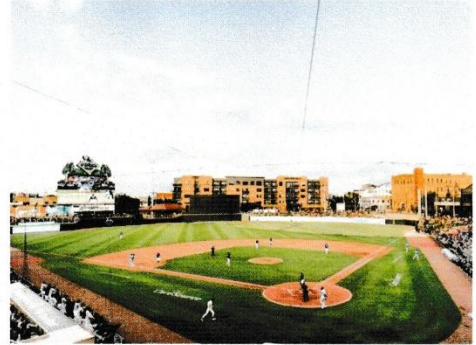
